

GETTING STARTED

The Testing Department has been working hard to ensure that you are provided with all the information you will need in regard to district and state testing. Just like last year, some assessments can be completed from home while others require your child to come on campus. This year, state testing that is completed on campus will be at the OCVS campus and <u>not</u> your child's home-zoned school. 




