

Thank you for your support in a successful start to testing this year. We are thrilled to share that during FAST PM1 we had 96% of our students in grades K-10 complete the assessment! We know that remote testing brings some challenges so remember that for any test that is offered as remote, you can always register to bring your child on campus to complete the exam. If you ever have any questions about On Campus testing, please email us at <u>OCVSTesting@ocps.net</u>

We have wrapped up FAST Testing PM1 and are now moving into STAR Math and High School tests. Students must register if they are planning on taking the following exams:

- PERT
- PSAT
- SAT
- ACT NCR
- EOC Retakes

STAR Math is given to our students who are currently taking Algebra 1 or Geometry. It is a progress monitoring test that will prepare students for the EOC in May. Students have been emailed a schedule of various remote sessions to choose from. (Remote Sessions can also be found at the top of the High School Testing Calendar on our OCVS Website.)

All information about testing can be found at the OCVS Website at <u>www.ocvs.ocps.net</u> Families can click on "Students" and then "Testing Info" to access everything you need for testing this year. We encourage you to look at the Testing Calendars under the "Quick Links" section to ensure you know what is coming up.

Just like last year, some assessments can be completed from home while others require your child to come on campus. This year, state testing that is completed on campus will be at the OCVS campus and **not** your child's homezoned school. (The only testing that might take place at a home zone school would be testing in May)






