

We want to take a moment to remind families that all testing from now until the end of the year must be completed **on campus**. <u>Remote testing is not an option</u>. \*\*The only students who can continue with remote testing are our Kindergarten, First, and Second Grade students.

Your child will begin receiving specific emails about their assigned testing location and day later this month. <u>If you have concerns about the date or location your child is scheduled to test, please reach out to us as soon as possible!</u> We can accommodate most requests if we are given enough time to make the changes, however, the closer we get to testing day the less likely it is that we can make changes. Please schedule time once a week to check your child's OCPS Gmail account which can be accessed on Launchpad. If you're not sure how to check that account, <u>here</u> is a video with directions.

#### **March Disability Awareness Month**

On February 26, 1987, President Ronald Reagan officially declared Proclamation 5613, making **March National Disabilities Awareness Month**. The proclamation called for people to provide understanding, encouragement, and opportunities to help persons with disabilities to lead productive and fulfilling lives.

Everyone wants, and deserves, to enjoy life, and feel productive and secure. But in March, we take extra steps to raise awareness about the support and rights of people with disabilities and to celebrate their contributions to our communities and society as a whole!

This class of disabilities can refer to impairments in learning and behavior, such as autism, attention-deficit/hyperactivity disorder, and impairments in physical and/or intellectual functioning such as cerebral palsy, spina bifida, and Down syndrome. The campaign seeks to raise awareness about including people with developmental disabilities in all facets of community life. It also creates awareness of the difficulties that people with disabilities still face in fitting into the communities in which they live.

All individuals, agencies, and organizations supportive of people with disabilities are encouraged to observe the month of March with appropriate observances and activities directed toward increasing public awareness of the contributions and the potential of Americans with disability.

When you improve your skills, you can feel a little less stressed about being tested.


### NATIONAL HONOR SOCIETY

#### Dear OCVS Families.

Beginning on Monday, March 4, 2024, Orange County Public Schools invites all students in grades 6-12 and all families with a student in grades K-12 to participate in the 2024 Annual Stakeholder Survey. These surveys offer valuable feedback as OCPS works to ensure every student has a promising and successful future.

#### What topics will be covered in the surveys?

- Student surveys will ask students about their thoughts on school climate, their sense of belonging, and teacher-student relationships.
- Family surveys will ask you about your thoughts on school climate, how easy it is to engage with our school, and how well we meet your child's needs and expectations.

#### When will my child take their survey?

- The student survey window is March 04 April 12, 2024.
- OCVS full-time students in grades 6-12 may be invited to take the survey during a live lesson or on their own time at home.

#### Is this survey mandatory?

• No, this survey is completely voluntary. Families can click on this link to the 2024 Annual Stakeholder Survey Non-Participation Form at any point during the survey window to notify Orange County Public School of their decision to not participate. Surveys completed before completing the non-participation form will not be reported.

#### How can I take the family survey?

- The family survey window is March 04 April 12, 2024
- Families can access the anonymous link to complete the survey at bit.ly/ocpsfamily
- The family survey is available in English, Spanish, Haitian Creole, Vietnamese, Arabic, and Portuguese and will take approximately 10 minutes to complete.

#### What if I have students at different OCPS schools or multiple students at the same school?


