### **Device Collection**



## **MATH**

**TEST season has arrived.** Here are two great strategies for preparing for tests.

Research shows that taking a practice test is one of the best ways to prepare.

### Follow these steps:

- Find practice tests in tools like Khan Academy and IXL OR ask your teacher for a resource.
- Set aside time to take the test. Try to make your environment similar to test day.
- · Identify the questions you get right and celebrate!
- Identify the questions you miss and find instruction and practice to help with those skills. Ask your teacher or coach for help.



Please note: this is the last event of the school year. Club has one more meeting in April and then will resume in September 2024. Thank you for an amazing year!








